2021-2022 SEASON FINANCIALS RECAP

- 2021-2022 Season Final
- It costs roughly \$1400 per athlete for the competition season
- The Booster Club lost roughly \$144 per athlete
- Able to absorb the loss with carry over from prior years
- AWC averaged \$475 net per gymnast past 5 years


- Distribution list is directly from OGBC portal

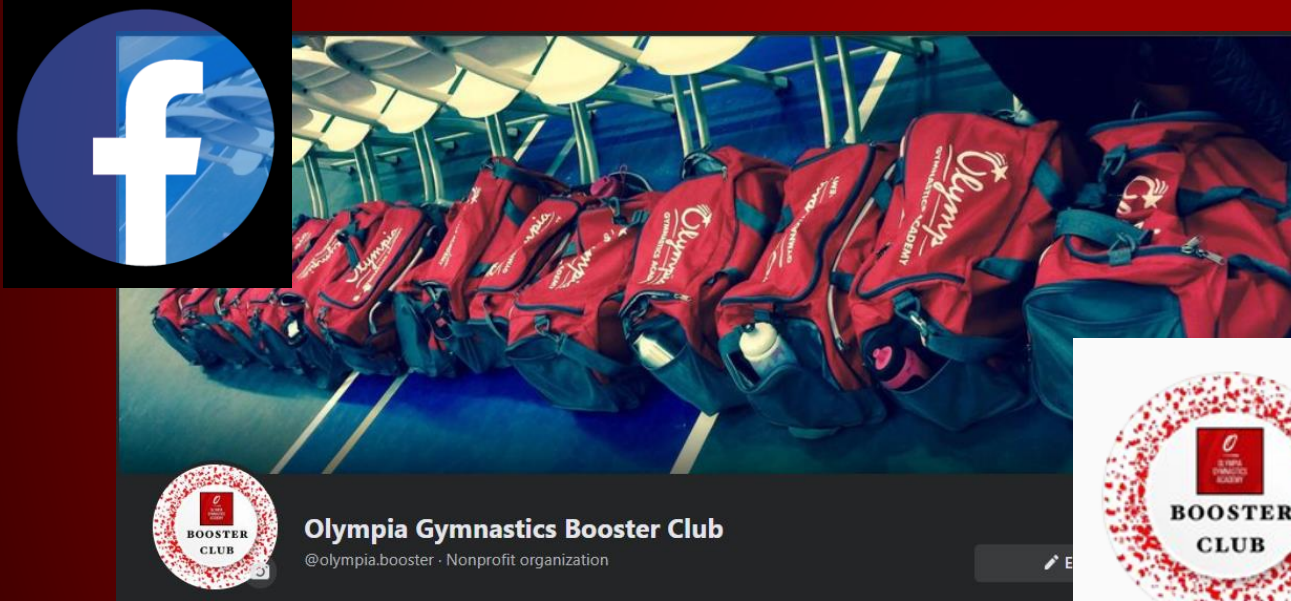
